



STATOIL ARTSSMARTS SCHOLARSHIP

Statoil, in partnership with the ArtsNL, is offering a \$2,500 art scholarship to high school students commencing first year full-time art studies in a degree or diploma program at a recognized publically funded Canadian university or college in fall 2018.

The application itself is divided into **four** sections. Below is the information that will be required in the application.

The application requires the submission of an artist statement. It is recommended that you have your statement complete prior to the application process. Given the high volume of applications at deadline, it is a good idea to submit a few days early to prevent any submission delays.

1. **Personal Information** (using the application form)
 - Provide basic contact details, including email, phone number, mailing address
 - Provide information about your high school and your intent to enroll in a degree or diploma program at a recognized publically funded Canadian university or college as a full time student in the fall 2018 academic term as well as confirming a minimum 70% average for your last completed year of study, etc.
2. **Artist Statement** (attach a separate page)
 - The artist statement should include your reason for wanting to be a professional artist, a description of artists and/or works that you admire, and your academic and artistic goals. Your statement should be 300-500 words (double spaced) in length. Be sure to include your name at the top of your statement.
3. **Letter of Recommendation** (attach a separate page)
 - A letter of recommendation from a current or past educator familiar with your artistic qualifications should be attached to your application.
4. **Civic Engagement** (attach a separate page)
 - Taking the initiative to get involved in your community (whether through volunteer activities, internships, or paid work experience) is important to demonstrating your commitment to leading change. Provide information (Company/Organization Name, Description of Engagement, Company/Organization Contact Name/Details, and Hours Volunteered/Worked) on your civic engagement.

Upon receipt of your application, a confirmation e-mail will be sent to you with 24 hours. If you do not receive confirmation within 24 hours or require additional information, please email rwinsor@nlac.ca.
